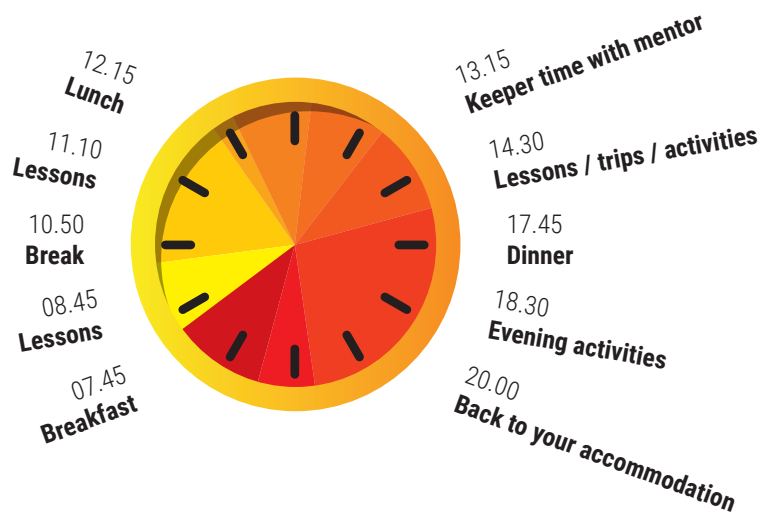

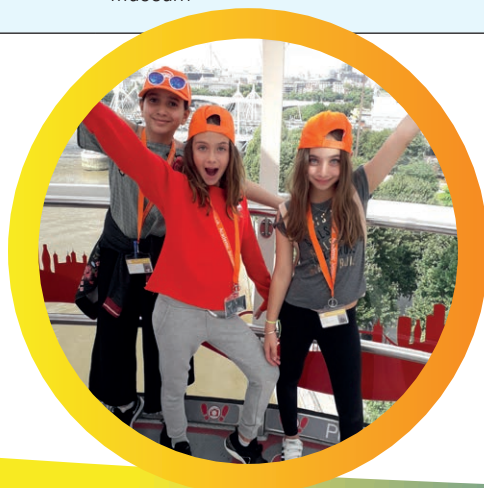

# Get Ready for Medicine (London)

Our medicine programme is an intensive two-week course, tailor-made for students who want to study medicine. Our interactive and innovative programme is led by UK medical students who can share and advise you from their own personal experiences.

## Our Get Ready for Medicine programme involves 40 hours of concentrated teaching per week and includes:

- First Aid course leading to a qualification
- Medical related trips including a visit to a medical school
- Visit to a hospital and medical research facilities
- Teamwork, leadership, communication and problem solving workshops
- Medical ethics and clinical scenarios; clinical workshop with a doctor
- Biology and chemistry practicals, including a heart dissection
- Personal statement and interview practice
- UKCAT and BMAT practice

The global reputation of UK universities is worldwide and many UK institutions are ranked amongst the best in the world. If you choose this course you will learn the process of applying to top universities.

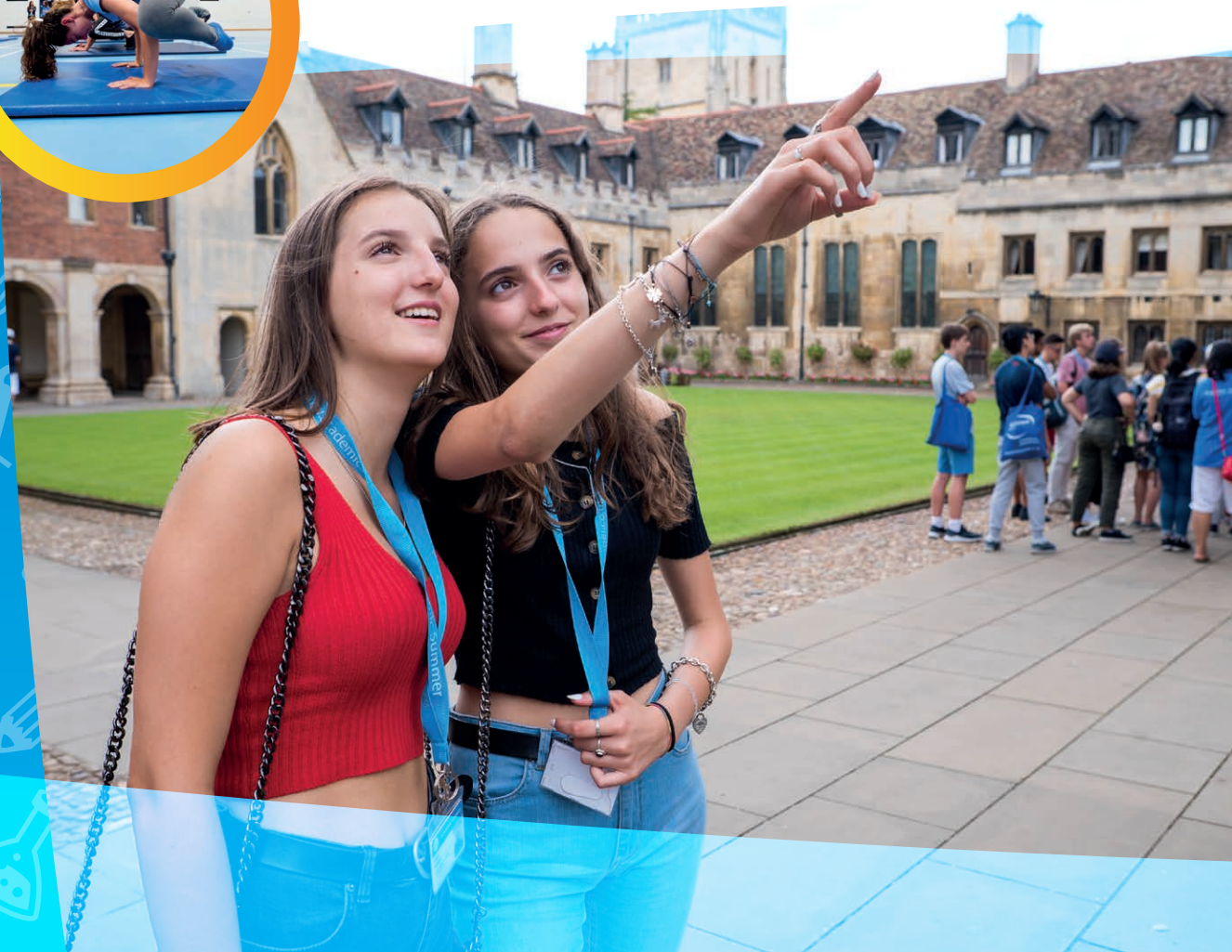

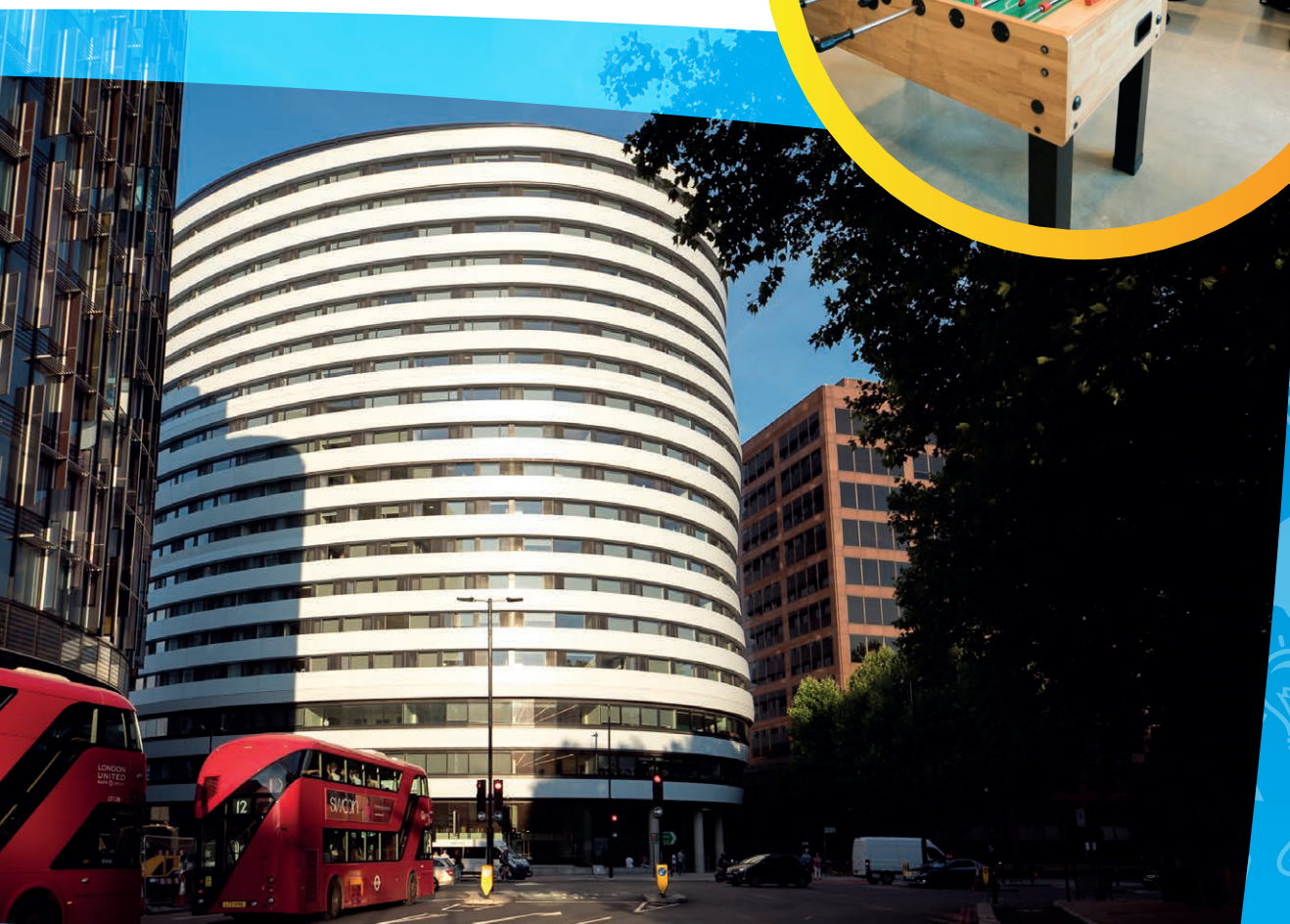
