ABOUT THE CAMP

- Operating for more than 18 years, the camp hosts approximately 200 students from 21 countries
- The camp welcomes students aged 13 - 18 and is offered in July and August
- An excellent transition for students enrolled with the NSISP
- Students can participate for a minimum of 1 week and a maximum of 8 weeks
- Daily schedule includes three meals, classes and activities (no classes on weekends)
- Counsellors live on-site to run all activities and offer caring support for students
- Classes have a student to teacher ratio of 16:1



LOCATION & ACCOMMODATIONS



- Nova Scotia is Canada's Ocean Playground, famous for seafood, beaches, and friendly people
- Located on the east coast of Canada - 2 hour flight from Toronto and 6 hours from London
- Camp is located only 45 minutes from Halifax International Airport (YHZ)
- The town of Truro is centrally located and has approximately 32,000 people
- 97% English speaking population in Truro and the surrounding community
- The camp is held at Nova Scotia Community College - Truro Campus (www.nsc.ca/truro)
- Students live in a residence building and rooms are shared with two students per room
- Boys and girls are separated in the residence; laundry facilities on site; 24-hour security

ADVENTURE ACTIVITIES

- The camp offers fun and exciting activities each day, including Saturday and Sunday
- Activities include sports, local festivals, events and more
- The camp offers on-campus exploratories such as arts/crafts, theme parties, yoga, etc.
- Students will explore Nova Scotia's beaches, sightseeing destinations, and tourist attractions
- All activities are supervised by qualified and professional staff and counsellors
