SCHOOL PROFILE

The Knox School was established in 1904 to be a school rich in music and art, close to the cultural advantages of New York City. Today, it is a co-educational boarding school for students where rigorous academics are combined with athletic and artistic pursuits. Knox offers an Honors Portfolio program for every upper school course, 27 elective courses in both the humanities and sciences, and Advanced Placement courses. With a full time college counselor, Knox successfully prepares young men and women to gain admission to leading colleges and universities.

FACILITIES

Campus buildings include the Bancroft-Phinney Gymnasium (basketball court, new Fitness Center, new dance studio, new locker rooms), four tennis courts, an outdoor basketball court, soccer and baseball fields, a lacrosse field, and an equestrian riding ring with its own horse stable.

SPORTS AND ARTS

Knox's students learn the importance of training and skill building as they compete in a variety of interscholastic sports, and win their share of games and championships — particularly the equestrian program. At Knox there is a special importance placed on the arts. Students have the opportunity to display their own arts in Solarium Gallery.

DORMITORIES AND STUDENT LIFE

Knox has six dormitories— three for girls, three for boys. All houses have common room, large screen TV, microwave, refrigerator, and some have a kitchen. Most have laundry in the house. There are three house parents per house.
