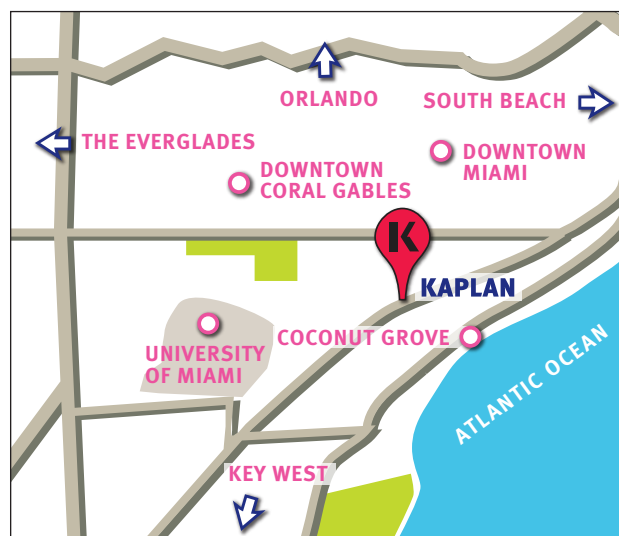

Classrooms

We have 8 comfortable classrooms with access to multimedia equipment and innovative SMART Boards®.

Multimedia and IT center

Kaplan International Miami has a computer lab equipped with 13 computers for diagnostic testing.

Cafeteria

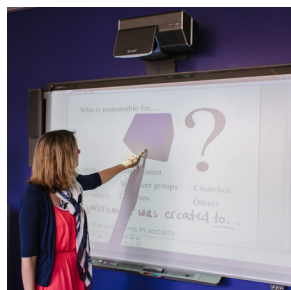
There is no cafeteria on site though there are many cafes, restaurants and other dining options adjacent to the Miami center and in the vicinity.

Orientation Information

On the first day of your course please report to the Kaplan International Miami school.

Your first day will be a Monday unless there is a national holiday on the Monday - in which case your first day will be Tuesday.

Your course will begin with an all-day introduction, which will include:

- Break
- Placement tests

Wireless internet access is available at the Kaplan International school.



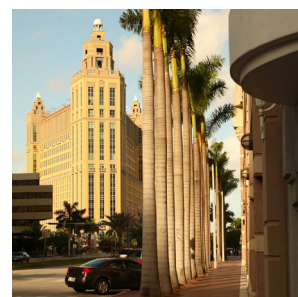
